Why Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) Matters?

At the College of Law, Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) is one of the simplest ways to make postgraduate study more achievable. It rewards your prior learning by reducing the commitment and helping you progress your career sooner.

1. No extra paperwork

There's no additional forms to have your prior study assessed beyond the standard enrolment. RPL automatically reduces the number of subjects you need to complete, lowering your fees and workload.

2. Save money

RPL saves you up to \$8,300 in course fees - the equivalent of 2 subjects off your Master of Laws (LLM).

3. Save time

RPL gives you a head start on your LLM with up to 2 subject credits, reducing your study time by up to 6 months.

Who Can Apply for Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL)?

1. College of Law PLT Graduates

By completing your PLT with the College of Law in the last 10 years, you may apply for up to 2 elective subjects of unspecified credit. Equivalent to saving 6 months of study and \$8,300 in course fees.

2. Practical Legal Training (PLT) Graduates from Other Providers

If you've completed your PLT with another provider in the last 10 years, you can still take advantage of prior learning. You may apply for one elective subject of unspecified credit. Equivalent to saving 12 weeks of study and \$4,150 in course fees.

3. Legal Practice Management Course (LPMC)

By completing your LPMC with the College, you may apply for one elective subject of unspecified credit towards your Master of Laws (LLM). Shape your career in your chosen area for less by saving 12 weeks of study and \$4,150 in course fees.

4. Other Postgraduate Study or Specialist Accreditation

By completing previous postgraduate study, such as a Graduate Diploma with the College, you may be recognised for unspecified credits towards a Master of Laws (LLM). Chat with our postgraduate team to build your study plan.

Accredited Specialists may qualify for exemption from foundations subjects and the Capstone Project in your chosen major, so you can focus on new areas of learning. Equivalent to saving 6 months of study and \$8,300 in course fees.


