
Introduction

The main purpose of this journal is to provide you with opportunities to:

- apply, test and reflect on what has been learned during the *15-day minimum period of work experience* (which must be undertaken in Australia, and either concurrently with or after the coursework component), when you are interacting with practising lawyers, other staff, government officers and clients; and
- reflect on the nature of legal practice and your aptitude for engaging in it.

Submission and Assessment

Submission of the journal is compulsory for all students, except those undertaking the CEM work experience option. If you are undertaking the CEM option for work experience, submission is not required as reflective analysis occurs during the CEM.

This journal should cover *only the minimum 15-day period of work experience* (referred to above). *If you undertake multiple placements to complete the 15-day minimum period, you should complete the journal for each of those placements.*

The journal will be assessed as to the adequacy of your reflection on that work experience. Please follow indicative word count for each question. Note that text boxes expand to enable you to provide a full answer. Your answers must demonstrate insight into the value gained from the work placement.

You should discuss your journal with your supervisor, who is required to sign at the end of the journal before you submit it. The supervisor may also use it as a framework for providing you with feedback.

Instructions

1. Describe how your work experience has contributed to your understanding of what a legal practitioner does in the course of legal practice. You should reflect and give 3 specific examples of how your understanding was challenged or confirmed by the work experience. (300-500 words)

3b. Reflect and describe how these experiences are likely to influence your future actions. (200-300 words)
